

and enable them to take care of their own vehicle safety and maintenance. The women learned how to check tires, check their oil, and other things pertinent to the vehicle and the women's safety. With storms and possible evacuations coming, we also talked about hurricane and emergency preparation. Using the money from the grant, we were able to give the women vouchers for oil changes at **Bobby's Coastal Auto Repair** and they each received a bag with car care items and a bag with emergency supplies.
