

Step up! Get Involved! Volunteer!

We are very grateful for all the volunteers God sends to Samaritan Ministries. This ministry would not be possible without them. Lately this has been made even more clear since we have had several weeks of illness among the staff here at Samaritan Inn. Even though we have been blessed with wonderful volunteers and a faithful volunteer staff there are several projects that still need to be completed around the Inn that we would appreciate your help with. Often projects have to be prioritized with a focus on keeping the Inn open. Could you or someone you



know help us with the following projects? Many of them have needed to be done for a long time.

The driveway needs some excavation and about \$500 in concrete to finish the city approved expansion. There is a concrete mixer available and a skid of Sakrete, concrete mix, can appear on any given day (not Sundays) if there are volunteers that will show up to help. A donation of the \$500 would be greatly appreciated.

Getting the yard mowed is always a challenge. The residents are often able to do that, but they are all working so often they do not have the time. We could use a person to come twice a month in the summer (April to November) to mow and weed eat with our equipment. Also, a donation of a dependable riding lawn mower that can be used would be extremely helpful.



We made a private office area in the Inn so that clients can be counseled and board meetings can be held where personal issues can be discussed. The sound proofing was completed since it was urgently needed, but the cosmetic finishing has not been finished. If someone does drywall finishing, they would be welcome to come volunteer to finish around two 4X6 foot areas.

We have a shed in the back yard that needs to be re-organized. We have been working on it, but we need about a dozen milk crates to be able to pack up those things that need to be stored or donated. Cardboard boxes attract roaches and the shed is not waterproof at the floor, so they deteriorate. We have good metal shelves to store things up off the floor, once everything is cleared out. Volunteers can be scheduled in to help once we have the crates.
