New Life: *Holly's Story (One U.S. Veteran who survived a personal battle!)

From the book of Luke 10:30-37, the parable of the Good Samaritan is one of the most inspiring that I have ever read. We know how much it pleases the Lord our God when we are of service to our brothers and sisters in Christ, and hence Samaritan Ministries.

I fled to Florida a year ago to escape a marriage consumed by domestic violence. My husband had torn up every piece of identification I had. In order to apply for assistance here, I needed a valid Florida I.D. I found the number for Samaritan Ministries on the Flagler County resource list given at the domestic violence shelter.

I called and spoke with the ministry director, Lorraine Vickery, who empathized with my situation and offered encouragement. A few days later, she took me to the Social Security office in Port Orange so I could get a new social security card. The next stop was at the Department of Motor Vehicles so I could also acquire a new I.D. It came as a blessing that the ministry paid for both as I had no money at the time.

Since then, Samaritan Ministries has helped me with food, bath tissue and personal necessities. I will always have respect and appreciation in my heart for this organization. Its continued support makes me feel important and loved.
